Job title: Climbing Program Route Setter (Volunteer Position)

GENERAL FUNCTION:

Develop and set exciting new climbing routes in order to keep the YMCA of Pueblo's climbing programs fresh and exciting.

KNOW-HOW:

The Climbing Program Route Setter must have a thorough understanding of the YMCA's mission and goals. A good knowledge of climbing safety, procedures and techniques is essential. The ability to climb a 5.10 is required.

Person must have the ability to communicate policy and procedure, handle inquiries, diffuse problems in a friendly and professional manner and be a team player.

A high school diploma or equivalent, experience in climbing programs, people management skills and First Aid, CPR & AED certification and blood borne pathogen training are required.

PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES:

- Develop new routes on the wall.
- Accurately rate climbs.
- Develop a route rotation system whereby 30% of routes are rotated on a monthly basis.
- Attend all staff meetings and training events.

The Climbing Wall Route Setter will keep the climbing wall new and exciting. This will help the YMCA to continue offering great programs that ensure the YMCA of Pueblo is viewed as the center of Pueblo's Climbing Community.
